Section II: School's Statement of Purpose

The Copper Country Christian School has a three-fold purpose for its existence:

Students applying for Preschool/K4, Kindergarten, or 1st Grade must be age 4, 5, or 6, respectively, by July 1 of the year in which they enroll.
